

INTERNATIONAL JOINT COMMISSION

IN THE MATTER OF THE APPLICATION OF ST. CROIX PAPER COMPANY, OF WOODLAND MAINE, FOR APPROVAL OF THE CONSTRUCTION OF A STORAGE DAM IN THE ST. CROIX RIVER AT VANCEBORO, MAINE AND ST. CROIX, NEW BRUNSWICK.

SUPPLEMENTARY ORDER
25 September, 1990

to the Order Prescribing Method of Regulating the Levels of Spednik Lake, dated 15 October, 1965.

WHEREAS the Commission has been informed that the Georgia-Pacific Corporation is the successor to the St. Croix Paper Company and the St. Croix Water Power Company and has assumed their responsibilities under the Commission's Order of October 15, 1964; and

WHEREAS flows in the St. Croix River Dam at Vanceboro, Maine and St. Croix, New Brunswick are regulated by the provisions of the Commission's Order Prescribing the Method of Regulating the Levels of Spednik Lake dated 15 October, 1965; and

WHEREAS Condition 5(a) of that Order requires that there be a minimum flow of $5.66\text{m}^3/\text{s}$ (200 cfs) through the Dam at all times; and

WHEREAS Georgia-Pacific, by letter from Kleinschmidt Associates dated September 14, 1990, requested that the International Joint Commission authorize Georgia-Pacific to suspend the required minimum flow from the Dam for a period of two hours to inspect the project works; and


WHEREAS the Commission has been informed by its International St. Croix River Board of Control and its International Advisory Board on Pollution Control - St. Croix River that a flow stoppage for 2 hours during the month of September should have no adverse effects on interested parties or the fishery resource:

NOW THEREFORE THIS COMMISSION ORDERS AND DIRECTS that the request of Georgia-Pacific be hereby approved, subject to the following conditions:

(1) that Condition 5(a) of the above Order be suspended for a period not longer than 2 hours prior to 29 September, 1990 to enable Georgia-Pacific Corporation to carry out the above inspection, and

(2) that Georgia-Pacific submit a copy of the report on the inspection of the project works to the Commission as soon as possible.
